

Make sure you sign up for sharpening in advance and if your skater is skating on the day of the sharpening, please put an elastic band around the skate so that the sharpener knows which skates must be done first. Please note that there is only time for sharpening so you will need to book another time if you wish to be measured for and order new skates.

The Calgary Winter Invitational competition is coming up over the long weekend. This is a combined event, meaning both STARSkate and CompetitiveSkate events are offered. Skaters in CompetitiveSkate events will be hoping to achieve the necessary qualifying points for Sectionals in the fall. Good luck to everyone competing!
